Early Closure on Friday 18th December

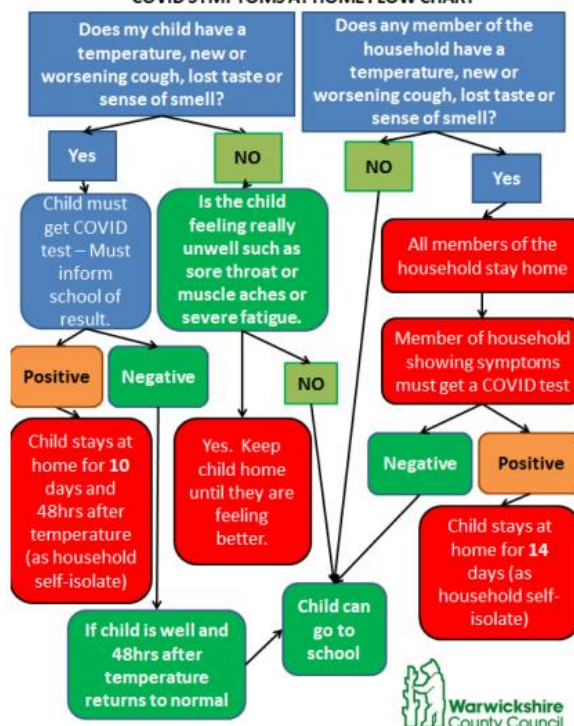
It has been agreed with the Governing Body that we will close early on the last day of term in line with many local and national schools.
