Following in the footsteps of Joe Roebuck (Olympic swimmer) and Meghan Beesley (GB 400m hurdler), we are delighted to welcome Darren Harris to Kingsway on Friday 25th September.

Darren is a dual Paralympian and England's most capped and most decorated blind footballer. He represented team GB in the London Paralympics and has won 7 World Championship medals over the course of his career.
